

## Sundays at St Aidan's

This table is a plan for Sunday gatherings at St Aidan's within the current level of COVID-19 restrictions. If restrictions change (either heightened or decreased) this will be revisited. This way forward is the result of meeting with wide cross section of the St Aidan's church family, in formulating this proposal we have sought to reflect principles which underpin the God given purposes of church, i.e. to Love God (Matt 22:36-40), Love one another (John 13:34-35), Love the world (John 3:16, 1 Tim 2:4). The key changes to note are:

1. Ten30church will begin meeting at Seventh Day Adventist building on Oct 11, the last 'Church in the carpark' will be Oct 4.
2. We invite members of St Aidan's to consider moving to church@5, especially if this would enable you to better love God, one another, and the world.
3. The pre-recorded service will be phased out and we encourage all who are joining online to do so via the Livestream Zoom link.
